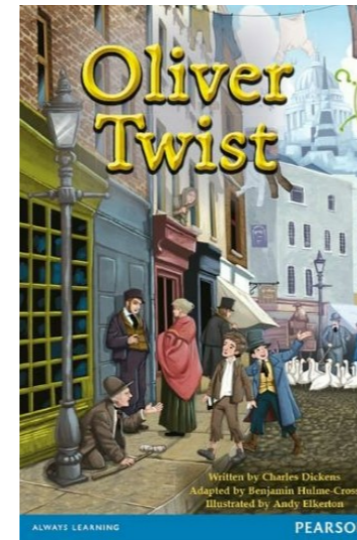
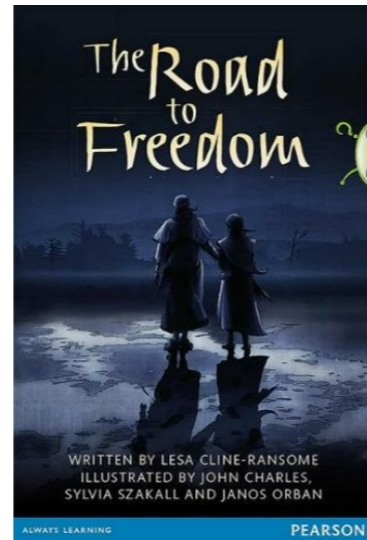


In Science we will learn...

Books we will read include...



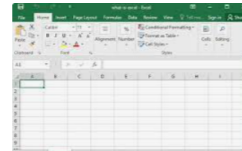
In Music we will...
